Before You Begin

- Clear the room of all debris and thoroughly clean the floors.
- Verify that manual air and water shut-offs are installed.
- Purge any debris from air and water lines.
- Check with local building and code authorities about installation requirements specific to your location.

- 5/32" hex key
- #2 Pozidriv[®] screwdriver
- Dollies (at least 2 per cabinet)

NOTE Information that is critical to a successful installation is shaded like this note throughout the guide.

CAUTION To avoid damaging the cabinet after the alcoves and the upper components have been installed, do not move the assembly more than is required to make slight position adjustments without installing the column covers.

For column cover installation information, see "Install a Structural Column Cover" on page 34.



ATTENTION Circuit boards are sensitive to static electricity. Electrostatic Discharge (ESD) precautions are required when touching a circuit board or making connections to or from the circuit board. Circuit boards should be installed only by an electrician or qualified service person.




WARNING Failure to install the A-dec Inspire 591 as described in this installation guide may cause the unit to collapse, resulting in serious injury to personnel.




WARNING Two people should install this cabinet to avoid personal injury.









2 Remove the doors and false bottoms.




TIP Make note of the installed location of each item to help with reinstallation.




- **3** Remove the storage drawers.
 - 1 Pull the drawer out to the stop.
 - 2 Lift the front of the drawer, pull out, then down.



4 (Optional) To remove the swing-out shelves, lift the left side tab up and push the right side tab down while sliding out the shelf.



TIP To move the rails into the cabinet so they are out of the way while completing the installation, center the tab in the middle of the rail then push the rail in.



6 Use a 7/16" socket and ratchet to remove the anchors securing the cabinet to the pallet. Lift and pull the anchors to remove them from the feet. Discard all anchors. Do not reuse anchors to secure the cabinets to the floor.

WARNING Due to the weight of larger configurations, more than two people are needed to safely move the cabinet from the pallet. Do not lift by the countertop.

7 Lifting by the lower rails, remove the cabinet from the pallet.

Prepare Cabinets Placed Against a Wall


Before a cabinet is positioned with its back against the wall, install the faucets. Use the manufacturer's instructions that ship with the product.

Also, if needed, make preparations for accessories, such as routing the ICV wiring or customizing the power panel for a nitrous oxide dispenser. These preparations can also be done after the cabinet is placed. See "Access the Power Panel to Install an Ancillary Device (optional)" on page 40 for instructions for accessing the power panel.


Secure the Lowers and Install the Countertop [98" [249 cm] configuration only]


Secure the Lowers

The 98" configuration ships in 70" and 28" (or two 14") sections. The 70" and 28" sections must be secured to each other.




1 Position the two sections of the 98" configuration next to each other while aligning the holes in each module.






2 Use four barrel bolts from the kit to secure the lower modules to


Install the Countertop



2 To secure the countertop to the rails, install the screws in the following locations according to the cabinet's configuration.




Quartz Countertop Over All Lowers



Solid Surface Countertop Over All Lowers


Screw for Solid Surface Countertops Actual Size

- **1** If the cabinet will be placed against a wall, reinstall the back panel.
- **2** Place the lower with support column in position.
- **3** Use a four-foot level to identify the high point of the floor by the cabinet, for both side to side and front to back.

TIP For a frame of reference while leveling, mark the high spot with a piece of tape in front of the cabinet.



Leveling Screw in a Cabinet Foot

STOP READ THIS! Read all of the next two pages before beginning the leveling procedure.



CAUTION When adjusting the leveling screw, be sure to

L use a 6 point socket. 12 point sockets can damage the screws.



CAUTION To maintain the complete look and functionality of the cabinet, do not raise the cabinet more than 3/4" (19 mm).

4 Starting at the ends of the cabinet, use a 5/16" socket and ratchet (with extension) to adjust the leveling screws as needed.




NOTE Extend the leveling screw (turn it clockwise) to raise the cabinet. Retract the screw to lower the cabinet.


5 Work from side to side and end to end. Adjust the leveling screws to raise cabinet sections until they are even with the high point and the entire cabinet is level.



NOTE Continue to alternate side to side and end to end adjustments during the entire leveling process.




Leveling Screw in a Support Column






Determine the Anchor Locations



For all configurations, it is recommended to place two anchors on the front feet of the 42" (106.7 cm) section and two anchors on the support column. **NOTE** If the cabinet is against a wall, remove the spacer bracket assembly with a Phillips head screwdriver to access the support column. Replace the bracket once the cabinet is anchored.




For 70" (177.8 cm) and 98" (248.9 cm) configurations, if it is not possible to get the rear anchors on the support column, place them on the rear outside feet.


Secure the Anchors


At each anchor location, complete the steps in the section for the type of floor. See the next page for wood floors.

Concrete Floors




Wood Floors





- Place the washer on the anchor bolt, then insert the bolt through the anchor into the hole.
- **3** Use a 3/4" socket and ratchet to tighten the bolt until it is snug against the washer and firmly secures the cabinet to the floor.




CAUTION If the system includes a drop-down shelf, do not remove the packaging inside of the shelf compartment until the upper is installed. The packaging provides structural support needed until the upper is secured.


- **1** Route the cables down the support column to the base of the cabinet.
- **2** Position the upper on the support column.
- **3** Use a standard screwdriver to lock the cams on both sides.
- **4** On both sides, use four screws to secure the L-bracket to the upper.
- **5** Thread two 1/4" bolts from the lower L-bracket to the upper one. Begin with the back bolts on each side and turn each bolt an equal amount, then do the same for the front bolts. Repeat this process until level.

I Install the Control Center (optional)


NOTE The door that includes the control center ships in its own box.



1 Insert the door and secure it on the hinges.




Route the wires into the chase and through the bottom of the upper.
 If the system includes a flip-down shelf, see "Route Control Center Cables Through the Flip-Down Shelf (optional)" on page 20 for additional routing instructions.



G Install the Flip-Down Shelf (optional)


NOTE If the system includes a control center, install it before installing the flip-down shelf. For instructions, see "Install the Control Center (optional)" on page 18.

Route Control Center Cables Through the Flip-Down Shelf (optional)




- **3** Route the cables into the chase and down the support column.
- **4** Install the chase cover.
- **5** Use four screws to install the strain reliefs.

2 Use a power screwdriver with a Phillips head bit and four self-tapping screws to secure the panel.






3 Install a cover cap on each screw, then use four screws to secure the corner covers.









If the system includes a monitor mount, install it now. For installation instructions, see the installation guide that ships with the product.



7 If the system includes two alcoves, repeat the steps on the other side of the support column.



- **1** Align the pins in the bottom of the dispenser with the keyhole opening in the alcove.
- **2** Lower the dispenser onto the alcove and slide it toward the center section.









NOTE The clerestory is secured to the 42" (106.7 cm) cabinet section by installing four short screws through the bracket and into the holes in the frame of the clerestory.



1 Place the clerestory in position on top of the uppers.




2 Locate the four large access holes in the top of the 42" (106.7 cm) cabinet.




3 Insert a short screw, on the tip of a Phillips head screwdriver with extension, through the access hole and into the hole in the bottom of the clerestory. Secure the clerestory to the metal bracket.


Soffit * -d **1** Remove the front panels. **2** Place the soffit in position on top of the upper. . Þ **3** Use a Phillips head screwdriver to close the four cams.



- **4** 70" (177.8 cm) and 98" (248.9 cm) configurations only:
 - 1 Repeat steps 1 through 3 for each soffit that goes above a dispenser.
 - 2 Use two barrel bolts to secure each side soffit to the center soffit.




5 From the back, make sure the column cover is flush against the extension and maintains a consistent gap alongside the upper and lower (matching the door gaps if present).


Install a Structural Column Cover

Install structural column covers next to ends that are by alcoves and sinks to properly support the cabinet.





4 Insert the four column cover brackets inside the column cover (note the orientation in each section).






Install the Soap and Hand Sanitizer Dispensers

Prepare the Template

To protect it during shipping, the template ships with the fingers taped to the top of it. You must assemble the template before positioning it for the dispensers.










- **1** Remove the protective layer from the back of the template to expose the adhesive.
- **2** Position the template as follows and press to secure it to the back of the alcove.
 - **Side** Align the side of the template with the side of the back, opposite from the faucet, where the back begins to curve.
 - **Top** Align the top of the template with the bottom of the upper.

Install the Dispensers







- **1** Remove the protective layer from the back of the soap dispenser.
- **2** Position the soap dispenser with its top and right sides flush against the left side of the template, then secure it to the alcove. Anchor the dispenser using the screws that shipped inside it.
- **3** Remove the protective layer from the back of the hand sanitizer dispenser.
- **4** Position the hand sanitizer dispenser with its top and left sides flush against the right side of the template, then secure it to the alcove. Anchor the dispenser using the screws that shipped inside it.
- **5** To attach the drip tray, push it into the bottom of the hand sanitizer dispenser.

6 To remove the template, grasp it from its sides at the top and pull straight out.



TIP Pull with more pressure on one side of the template to make it easier to remove it.

Access the Power Panel to Install an Ancillary Device (optional)


If the system includes an ancillary device, it installs in the power panel. Complete the following procedure to access the power panel according to where the cabinet is located.

Free-Standing Cabinets

With the back panel removed, access the power panel directly from the back.

Against a Wall

If the cabinet is against a wall, separate the power panel from the support column to access the panel's back.



- **1** Pry off the access panels.
- **2** Remove four screws (two on each end) securing the panel to the support column.
- **3** Slide the power panel to the left to disengage the brackets on the panel from the brackets on the support column, and then pull the power panel out to remove it.

Install the ICV (optional)


If the system includes an ICV, see the installation guide that ships with the product.




Connect the Wires and Data Lines



1 Plug in the auxiliary devices (optional).

TIP The receptacles include a tamper-proof shutter to prevent unwanted articles from entering the receptacle. Apply equal pressure on each tine to slide open the shutter when inserting the plug. If you experience resistance entering the receptacle, gently rock the plug back and forth to open the shutter.

- **2** Connect the task light power, black to black, red to red.
- **3** If the system does not include a control center, connect the task light switch.
- 4 Connect the control center power, black to 0 VDC, white to 24 VDC (optional).
- **5** Plug in the data lines. It does not matter which data port the lines plug into.
- 6 Secure the wiring under the strain relief.



Set Up the Auxiliary Relays (optional)

Auxiliary relays are used to turn on/off devices plugged into the distribution box. They are operated from the control center and touchpads.

Jumpers specify which button on the control center and touchpad operates the power for that relay.

For each relay, position the jumper in one of the three numbered Aux positions.


If more than one relay in the same system is set to the same numbered Aux position, then they all turn on and off at the same time from the control center or touchpad.




NOTE If the system does not include a control center, do not set the jumper to Aux #3. It cannot be activated without a control center.

If a system without a cuspidor includes an A-dec 300 Deluxe touchpad or an A-dec 300/500 Standard touchpad, the bowl rinse button controls Aux # 1 and the cupfill button controls Aux #2.

Connect and Secure the Distribution Box




- **1** Position the cover at 90° to the distribution box and hook its end on the distribution box frame.
- **2** Rotate the cover down and use a Phillips head screwdriver to secure it to the distribution box.



CAUTION The distribution box plugs into the quad box. A licensed electrician or other qualified personnel is required to connect the quad box per local codes and regulations.

- **3** Place the distribution box inside the cabinet.
- **4** Use a Phillips head screwdriver to secure the green ground wire to the cover of the quad box.
- **5** Plug the distribution box into the quad box.



6 Under the cabinet, use one fastener to anchor the distribution box to the floor (the fastener is not included in the kit).

It does not matter which foot you choose to secure.




NOTE The distribution box can also be anchored inside the cabinet on the support column.

Adjust the Drawer Faces and Doors

Adjust the Drawer Faces

Adjust the face of the drawers to align them properly.

CAUTION To avoid damaging the screws, use a #2 Pozidriv screwdriver to adjust the screws that move the drawer faces.





Adjust the Doors


Adjust the door hinges to align the doors properly.

CAUTION To avoid damaging the screws, use a #2 Pozidriv screwdriver to adjust the door hinge screws.

Side to Side









For 155° hinges, close the door slightly for better access to the screw.

Up and Down









NOTE The screw on the hinge plate may be at the top or bottom, depending on the door configuration.

Back to Front








Install the Foot Pedal (optional)




Install the Base Covers

Complete the following instructions for the base covers



1 Place the base covers into position. Depending on their location, they attach onto magnets or are inserted into spring clips.




2 Place the rounded corner base covers on the front corners of the cabinet and the square covers on the back corners.

Finish the Installation


To complete the installation:

- Completely remove the protective film from the column covers.
- Install the hinge covers.
- Reinstall the false bottoms.
- If the cabinet is not against a wall, reinstall the back panel.
- Program the time, date, and language on the control center.
