Before You Begin

Check with local building and code authorities about installation requirements. They differ from state to state and internationally.



NOTE Information that is critical to a successful and safe installation is shaded like this note throughout the guide.

CAUTION When removing or replacing covers, take care not to damage any wiring or tubing. Verify that the covers are secure after replacing them.

The A-dec Performer monitor mount can be installed in two locations:

- Radius[®]-style dental light arm
- Support center intermediate post

The procedure for installing the monitor mount is the same for both installation locations, except for routing the cables.



READ THIS! The rigid arm or intermediate post must be installed before you begin this procedure. For more information, see the installation guide that came with the chair.

Required Part

To install the Performer monitor mount, you will need to supply a monitor cable. For ease of installation, A-dec recommends an HDMI cable, at least 15 ft (4.5 m) long. Adaptors may be required to connect the cable to the monitor or PC.

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CAUTION If you choose to use a power cord other than the supplied power cord (for example, a longer cord), use an SJT type cable when connecting power to the monitor. SJT cables are more durable than the SVT cables typically provided by monitor manufacturers and they are required when routed through moving arms.

- Do not use a monitor that weighs more than 20 lb.
- Use a monitor that fits a 75 mm or 100 mm VESA pattern mount.
- Always follow local building and electrical codes.

- 3/16" T-handle hex key


TIP We recommend that the monitor to be installed is available when you are installing the monitor mount to ensure proper installation.

Install the Monitor Mount

Task 1.



- **1** Remove the hole plug from the post.
- **2** Route the power cord into the post and out the bottom of the post.



NOTE Leave sufficient cable hanging out the top of the post to connect to the monitor.


3 Route the HDMI cable.



CAUTION Do not pull the cables fully tight or they may be damaged.

CAUTION Failure to provide range of motion for the cables can lead to product damage.

NOTE When installing on an intermediate post (used on the support center), position the hole in the post so that it faces toward the head of the chair.



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
Task 2.

1 Unscrew the clamping nut enough so that the whole nut can go inside of the rigid arm. Task 3. Beveled Edge Against the Inside of the Rigid Arm **1** Insert the clamping nut into the hole in the light rigid arm. **2** Slide the monitor mount down until it rests with its tab on the bottom lip of the hole. **3** Rest the beveled edge of the clamping nut against the inside of the rigid arm. **4** Let the monitor mount hang so Tab that its weight provides tension on the clamping nut.


Task 4.

1 With the beveled edge of the clamping nut against the inside of the rigid arm, align the mount.

- For a rigid arm installation, align the mount with the lower section of the rigid arm.
- On a support center post, align the mount with the cuspidor.








the clamping nut and rigid arm while tightening the securing screw.

NOTE When the monitor mount is properly secured, the clamp is flush against the rigid arm with no gap and is aligned with the lower section of the rigid arm (or with the water bottle support for installations on an intermediate post on a support center).

Task 6.



NOTE For installing monitors with a recessed mounting area, use the adaptor plate included with the kit.

Task 1. Turn off the power to the system.




DANGER Failure to turn off the power before you begin this procedure can lead to electrical shock.

WARNING Failure to turn off the power before you begin this procedure can lead to product damage and result in serious injury or death.

CAUTION Circuit boards are sensitive to static electricity. Electrostatic Discharge (ESD) precautions are required when touching a circuit board or making connections to or from the circuit board. Circuit boards should be installed only by an electrician or qualified service person.

Task 2. Complete the procedure for the system's configuration:

If you are installing the monitor mount on a dental light mounted on the support center, continue with the procedure "Route the Cables from a Support Center to the Floor Box" on page 11.



Task 1.




- **1** Position the chair so that it is raised halfway up.


Route the Cables

- **1** Route the wiring and tubing through the upper structure.
- **2** Starting at the slot in the lower post, install two wraps around the wiring and tubing. If there is tubing from equipment installed at the back-mount, include it in the wrap.



Route the Cables from a Support Center to the Floor Box

- Diagonal cutters




1 Remove the support center side covers on both sides.


Task 2.



- **1** Position the chair so that it is raised halfway up.
- **2** Press in on one side of the stop plate to disengage it from the lift arm and pull it away from the lift arm.




1 Plug in the chair.




- **2** To make routing the tubing and wires easier, use the jumper to move the chair base up (BSUP).
- **3** Unplug the chair.

1 Route the wires and tubing under the adaptor arm, through the upper structure, to the floor box.


Adjust the System

Adjust the Vertical Tension

The vertical tilt tension should prevent the monitor from drifting down but allow adjustments without requiring significant force.

Recommended Tool

• 3/16" hex key




Adjust the Rigid Arm Tension (Rigid Arm Installations Only)

Check that you can rotate the monitor mount without moving the rigid arm. If the rigid arm moves, use the following procedure to increase the tension on the rigid arm.

Recommended Tools

• 15/16" socket and ratchets (2)



1 Place the dental light in working position.

Test the System

Once the monitor is connected to a computer system, test the following:

- When you reposition the monitor, it moves smoothly, and the light rigid arm holds its position.
- After the monitor is in position, it does not drift.
- When you turn on the power to the monitor, it functions correctly.



CAUTION When removing or replacing covers, take care not to damage any wiring or tubing. Verify that the covers are secure after replacing them.




• 1/8" hex key

Task 1.




- **1** Tilt the monitor down as far as you can.
- **2** Place the cover over the bracket.
- **3** Use a 1/8" hex key to install the top screw.

Task 2.



2 Use a 1/8" hex key to install two screws in the bottom of the cover.

Install the Clamp Plug



1 Push the plug into the hole.

Final Steps

1. Reinstall the remaining covers.
