Pre-Installation Notes and Cautions



NOTE Job site construction should be completed before the dental equipment installation (including finished floors, ceiling, plumbing, lighting, paint, etc.).



CAUTION Local regulation may require licensed plumbers and electricians to install the utilities. All plumbing and utilities must conform to prevailing local codes.



CAUTION The manner and method for accessing the utilities within the wall is the responsibility of the design team working on the project (dental dealer, architectural services, and contractors). Utilities must be accessible without the use of tools.



CAUTION Consult a licensed professional, e.g., a structural or architectural engineer, for mounting to metal studs or masonry walls.

(With or without utilities) 2" x 6" (38 mm x 140 mm) minimum.


Non-Standard Wall Construction

7-1/2" (191 mm) depth minimum.


Other Construction Requirements



Utility Placement




Utility Elevations



A-dec 341pro/341flt Plan View with Elevation




A-dec 341pro/341flt Range of Motion




Standard Wood Wall Construction, 2" x 6" (38 mm x 140 mm) Minimum




Standard Wood Wall Construction with Utilities, 2" x 6" (38 mm x 140 mm) Minimum



Foot Control Wall Plate


Position the foot control wall plate in any location on the wall; there is no specific placement relationship with the 341pro/341flt mounting bracket.

Umbilical Pass-Through
